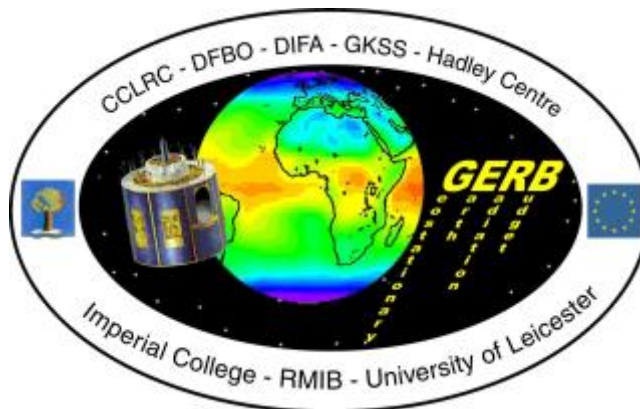

May 2017: A new data record of TOA solar and thermal flux based on Meteosat and covering 1983-2015 is now available through the CM SAF (<http://www.cmsaf.eu>). The GERB data is used “off-line” to tune the narrowband-to-broadband regressions for both the Meteosat first and second generations. The work is documented in the *Remote Sensing* paper:
